#### A. General

- 1. The published paper is the presented paper.
- 2. Page frame: A4 in Microsoft Word
- 3. Page limit: at most 25 pages including diagrams, tables, references, etc.

## B. Manuscript Preparation

- 1. Font: New Times Roman used throughout the text, with italic and bold styles reserved for special marking.
- 2. Text: 12 points, single spacing, fully justified
- 3. Single space unless specified
- 4. Margins: must be 3cm on all sides
- 5. No page number, headers, or footers

## C. Page Format

- 1. Title: 16 points, centered, bold
- 2. Author: 12 points, centered
- 3. Affiliation and email: 12 points, centered
- 4. Abstract: 12 points, single spacing
- 5. Up to 5 keywords should be provided separated by commas
- 6. Heading: Use general format (1; 1.1; 1.1.1), skip one line and begin paragraph

## D. Notes & Examples

- 1. Use footnotes (not endnotes). An asterisk (\*) at the end of the article title will refer to a footnote for acknowledgments; thereafter, all footnotes will be in an uninterrupted, numeric sequence, beginning with "1".
- 2. Order examples like this:
  - (1)
  - (2) a.

a'.

#### E. Citation formats:

As part of a running text: author (year), or author (year: page)

E.g., Smith (1984), Jones (1999:123)

As a parenthetic note: (author year), or (author year: page)

E.g., (Smith1984), (Jones 1999:123)

In general, avoid using titles, such as Dr., Professor, or Chairman.

## F. Quotations

For quotations that exceed two lines: one space below text, fully justified, 2 space indentation for entire quote, font size 12 points, skip one line and resume text

#### G. Illustration Guideline

Illustrations such as charts, graphs, drawings and diagrams should be labeled, so that they correspond with their mention in the text (e.g. Table 2, Figure 2, Diagram 3)

## H. Reference Format

12 points, use single-spacing Sample references
